



POINTS & RELATED PROGRAMS



The 2020 PDRA Racing series begins in Benson, North Carolina at GALOT Motorsports Park and closes the eight-race series in North Dinwiddie, Virginia at Virginia Motorsports Park. Contestants in each of the PDRA Racing series categories compete for the PDRA Racing World Championship title on a basis of total points earned across all eight series events.

POINTS EARNINGS

All Scheduled Races are Points Races

All points are awarded to the driver and cannot be transferred under any circumstances. Points are non-transferrable from one class to another. For any Top Junior Dragster (TJD) competitor that ages into Pro Junior Dragster (PJD) within the current year PDRA schedule, the competitor will transfer only their attendance points total to Pro Junior Dragster class (25 points per PDRA race attended), competition/round points will not be transferred. If the event is disrupted after eliminations of that category are in progress, those contestants unable to compete will be awarded points up to the round completed. Alternates will receive the participation points only (25 points). Top Sportsman 32 and Top Dragster 32 racers can count two (2) races on their overall points total if they end up in the Elite category. No more than two races can be claimed on overall points total from 32 to Elite. Elite non-qualifiers will not be able to interchange points. When a driver is reinstated, due to a competitor's non-performance violation, the reinstated driver will only receive point credits for previous round. If a green light driver is reinstated, due to a competitor's performance violation the reinstated driver may continue to receive points for future rounds of the event.

POINTS & RELATED PROGRAMS

Additional points are awarded as followed, per event:

25 Points for Participating in Event

- Competitor must take tree during at least one qualifying run under power to receive participation points.

50 Points for Elapsed Time Record (1% Back Up Required)

- Points and/or monetary awards may be withheld from any contestant who is in non-compliance with the rules or their particular class, general regulations or PDRA's mandatory decal requirements.

Tie Breaker

In the unlikely event a tie should occur, the following procedure would be used to determine a winner.

1. Most event wins.
2. Most event runner-ups.
3. Most number of events entered.
4. Most event round wins.

Should a tie still exist after the above procedures are implemented, the tied competitors will be declared co-champions and all awards (where possible) will be shared equally between the co-champions.
